With a history stretching back over eight hundred years to 1179, when Henry II granted a charter which empowered the Burgesses of Preston to hold a Guild Merchant, 2012 will be the first Guild since Preston was awarded City status in 2002 and the first Guild of the 21st Century.

## **PROCESSIONS**

#### **Trades Procession**

#### Sat 1st. 11am City Centre

The first of four huge processions is Trade - the very heart of the Guild Merchant. Although much has changed, the Trades Procession is the direct descendant of the first processions of traders, craftsmen and merchants dating back to at least 1762 (the earliest documentary evidence).

Enjoy the spectacular display of decorated floats and walkers that represent the current day industries, businesses and public services of the city.

#### **Churches Procession**

In the afternoon the Churches of Preston and the surrounding districts will come together to process through the City Centre streets. If previous Guilds are anything to go by, thousands will line the route to witness this traditional event.

The Churches Organising Committee will weave the six Guild themes through the story of 'The Living Christ', starting with the resurrection and ending with G for God with a colourful procession of thousands.

The Torchlight Procession is the only Guild procession to take place in darkness. This is a great opportunity to see Preston differently as illuminated floats and costumed walkers carrying burning torches, take to the streets. This, the last procession of the Guild, traditionally draws the largest crowds for this spectacular show of music, light, colour, drama and fun. More than 100,000 people lined the streets in 1992 celebrating this procession which dates back to 1882.


